Confession of Faith

Minister: Christians, what do you believe?

Congregation: God remembered his promise to reconcile the world to himself; he has come among us in Jesus Christ, the eternal Word made flesh. He is the long-awaited Savior, fully human and fully divine, conceived by the Spirit of God and born of the virgin Mary. Being both God and man, Jesus is the only Mediator between God and his people. His electing love sustains our hope: God’s grace is free to save sinners who offer nothing but their need for mercy.
