Old Testament Reading: Ecclesiastes 12

Confession of Sin: Psalm 32:1-7

Leader: Blessed is the one whose transgression is forgiven,

whose sin is covered.

Congregation: Blessed is the man against whom the Lord counts no iniquity, and in whose spirit there is no deceit.

Leader: For when I kept silent, my bones wasted away through my groaning all day long.

Congregation For day and night your hand was heavy upon me; my strength was dried up as by the heat of summer.

Leader: I acknowledged my sin to you, and I did not cover my iniquity;

Congregation: I said, "I will confess my transgressions to the Lord," and you forgave the iniquity of my sin.

Leader: Therefore let everyone who is godly offer prayer to you at a time when you may be found;

Congregation: surely in the rush of great waters,

they shall not reach him.

All: You are a hiding place for me; you preserve me from trouble; you surround me with shouts of deliverance.
